

## ORDINANCE 1280

### AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 1264, SECTION 7, AN ORDINANCE DEFINING THE DOWNTOWN PARKING DISTRICT, PROHIBITING EMPLOYEE, EMPLOYER, VOLUNTEER, RESIDENT, RESIDENT VISITOR AND STUDENT PARKING WITHIN THE DOWNTOWN PARKING DISTRICT AND DEFINING PARKING CONTROL ZONES AND SIGNS

**WHEREAS**, the City of Tillamook adopted Ordinance 1264 amending Ordinance 1216, Section 7 on January 3, 2012, and

**WHEREAS**, the Tillamook City Council wishes to amend Ordinance 1264, Section 7.

**NOW THEREFORE**, the City of Tillamook amends Ordinance 1264, Section 7 as follows:

#### **Section 7: Limited Exemption(s) from ordinance Application**

- (1) Any person, group, or business may apply to the City for a limited exemption from certain restrictions imposed by this ordinance, within the Downtown Parking District. All other laws and or ordinances shall remain in full force and effect. Exemption may be requested in writing, to the City Manager, who, upon review of the requested, approve the request in full or part, or present the request to the appropriate committee, to then be presented to the Council for approval.
  
- (2) Vehicles with appropriately displayed current handicap placards or license shall be exempt from timed parking as indicated in Oregon Revised Statutes. In addition, employees, employers and residents in the Downtown Parking District are also exempt from employee, employer, resident parking restrictions when appropriately displaying current handicap placards or license and are parked in a signed, marked handicap parking space in the Downtown Parking District.
