

ORDINANCE 1286

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 1173 AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR A BUSINESS REGISTRATION UPON TRADES, PROFESSIONS, OCCUPATIONS, BUSINESSES AND SHOPS FOR THE PURPOSES OF PROVIDING FOR THE HEALTH, SAFETY AND WELFARE OF THE CITIZENS OF TILLAMOOK AND FOR RAISING REVENUE FOR MUNICIPAL PURPOSES; PROVIDING FOR THE METHOD OF ISSUING A BUSINESS REGISTRATION AND COLLECTING FEES AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION THEREOF AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the City of Tillamook adopted Ordinance 1175 on June 17, 2002; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance 1175, Section 3, provides language pertaining to commencement and licensing requirements within the city limits of Tillamook, Oregon; and

WHEREAS, the Tillamook City Council wishes to amend 1175, Section 3, pertaining commencement of business operations.

NOW THEREFORE, the City of Tillamook ordains as follows:

Section 1: Amendment.

Ordinance 1173, Section 3 shall be amended to include the following language pertaining to license issuance:

Section 3: Commencement:

On or after July 1, 2002, any person who operates a business or conducts business within the jurisdiction of the City of Tillamook, Oregon, shall first obtain a business registration registering that business. The applicant shall apply on a form approved by the City and shall pay a fee for the registration in advance.

Any person that carries on or engages in a business that does not comply with City, State, or Federal law is prohibited from being issued a business license.

Section 2: Effective Date.

The City Council of Tillamook finds the health, safety and welfare of Tillamook citizens will best be served by this Ordinance taking immediate effect, whether by an emergency now declared or, alternatively, by its effective date retroactively applied to the date this ordinance is passed by this Council. Therefore, the City Council hereby declares this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from the time of its passage and approval


