

ORDINANCE NO. 1314

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CODE OF THE CITY OF TILLAMOOK, TITLE III,
CHAPTER 35, FINANCES; TAXES AND FEES; SECTION 35.015; TRANSIENT ROOM TAX, DEFINITIONS,
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the City of Tillamook wishes to amend the definition of OPERATOR listed in Code of Ordinances; Section 35.015.

The City of Tillamook ordains as follows:

Section 1. Amended Definitions.

OPERATOR. Any Owner, Person, Person in Charge of Property, or Person Responsible as defined in City Code Section 130; General Nuisances. ~~The person who is the proprietor of the hotel in any capacity. Where the OPERATOR performs his or her functions through a managing agent of any type or character other than an employee, local site manager, and/or managing agent shall also be deemed an OPERATOR for the purposes of this subchapter and shall have the same duties and liabilities as his or her principal. Compliance with the provisions of this subchapter by either the principal or the managing agent shall be considered to be compliance by both.~~

Section 2. Codification.

Provisions of this Ordinance shall be incorporated in the City Code and the word "ordinance" may be changed to "code", "article", "section", "chapter" or another word and the sections of the Ordinance may be renumbered, or re-lettered, provided however that any Whereas clauses and boilerplate provisions (i.e. Sections 15-19) need not be codified and the City Recorder is authorized to correct any cross-references and any typographical errors.

Section 3. Emergency.

This Ordinance being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this Ordinance takes effect on its passage and approval.


