

ORDINANCE NO. 1325

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 1310 SECTION 15
IN ORDER TO ALLOCATE TAX REVENUE**

WHEREAS, section 34a of House Bill 3400 (2015) provides that a city council may adopt an ordinance to be referred to the voters that imposes up to a three percent tax (3%) or fee on the sale of marijuana items by a marijuana retailer in the area subject to the jurisdiction of the city, and;

WHEREAS, the City of Tillamook adopted Ordinance 1310 on August 1, 2016 to tax the sale or transfer of marijuana and marijuana-infused products within the City, and;

WHEREAS, the voters of the City of Tillamook approved a three percent (3%) tax on the sale of marijuana and marijuana infused product at the November 8, 2016 general election, and;

WHEREAS, the City of Tillamook wishes to allocate revenue from the sale of Marijuana and Marijuana Infused Product.

NOW THEREFORE, The City of Tillamook ordains as follows:

Section 15 of Ordinance 1310 is to be amended to read as follows:

Section 1. Forms, Regulations and Allocation.

A. The City Manager is hereby authorized to prescribe forms and promulgate rules and regulations to aid in the making of returns, the ascertainment, assessment and collection of said medical marijuana tax and in particular and without limiting the general language of this chapter, to provide for:

- 1) A form or report on sales and purchases to be supplied to all vendors;
- 2) The records which sellers providing marijuana and marijuana-infused products are to keep concerning the tax imposed by this ordinance.

B. All revenue from the Marijuana and Marijuana Infused Product Tax shall be allocated for the support and assurance of public police protection within the Incorporated City Limits of the City of Tillamook.
