**AWARD**

The City of Tillamook intends to award Advanced Excavation Inc. the contract for the 5<sup>th</sup> Street Infrastructure project for work between Stillwell Ave and Main Ave which includes the design, build and replacement of selected sewer line laterals, dig out and repair sections of street that are in need of repairs and finish with a complete overlay of the street when the project is done, demo and installation of new sidewalks, approaches, and ramps that meet ADA requirements on 5th street between Stillwell Ave and Main Ave. The award is dependent upon contract/price negotiations to be prepared in following weeks. This Notice of Tentative Award is being provided to all vendors who received the initial RFB or subsequently requested a copy. The City is not responsible for any explanation, clarification, or interpretation in any manner.

Any respondent who has submitted a response to the City of Tillamook and who is adversely affected by the City of Tillamook's contract award to another respondent has 5 days after issuance of the Notice of Intent to award the contract, to submit a written protest of award to the City of Tillamook. Such right to protest shall conform to the requirements of OAR 137-0300104 (1) and specify the grounds upon which the protest is based. An adversely affected respondent must exhaust all avenues of administrative review and relief before seeking judicial review of the City of Tillamook's contract selection.
