

ORDINANCE NO. 1350

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CODE OF THE CITY OF TILLAMOOK (CCT), TITLE IX, GENERAL REGULATIONS, CHAPTER 92, USE OF CITY PARKS; ALLOWING DOGS ON-LEASH ON CITY TRAILS, ADOPTING A NO-TOBACCO USE RULE FOR ALL CITY PARKS, AND APPROVING A STANDARD APPLICATION FOR ORGANIZED FUNCTIONS IN THE PARK; AMENDING ORDINANCE 1192

WHEREAS, the City Parks Ordinance, enacted by Ordinance 1192, and set forth in chapter 92 of the Code of the City of Tillamook (CCT) states: *The city may adopt any rules and regulations for the use, management and supervision of the parks, squares, openings, public grounds and grounds surrounding public buildings or other places of recreation, now belonging or hereafter acquired by the city as may be reasonable or necessary; and*

WHEREAS, the Beautification Committee has reviewed the use of City parks relating to allowing dogs on-leash on city trails, prohibiting smoking and tobacco use in all city parks, and the need for a standard application in relation to organized functions in the park; and

WHEREAS, the Tillamook City Council believes it is reasonable to enact the provisions recommended by the Beautification Committee.

NOW THEREFORE, the City of Tillamook ordains as follows:

Section 1. Amendment of City Parks Ordinance.

Ordinance 1192 is hereby amended to include the provisions detailed in the attached Exhibits A and B.

Section 4. Codification.

Provisions of this Ordinance shall be incorporated in the Code of the City of Tillamook, Chapter 92, and the word "ordinance" may be changed to "code", "article", "section", "chapter" or another word and the sections of the Ordinance may be renumbered, or re-lettered, provided however that any Whereas clauses and boilerplate provisions (i.e. Sections need not be codified and the City Recorder is authorized to correct any cross-references and any typographical errors.

Section 5: Effective Date.

This Ordinance shall be in effect 30 days from the date of passage.
